 - ii. Adding more "learn to play" sessions to help with retention/growth.
 - b. Many public places have removed mask mandates and restrictions in general have gone down.
 - c. Continue with guidelines for staying home if testing positive or feeling poorly. Many players are already following this guideline. No other restrictions will be enforced for the outdoor events
